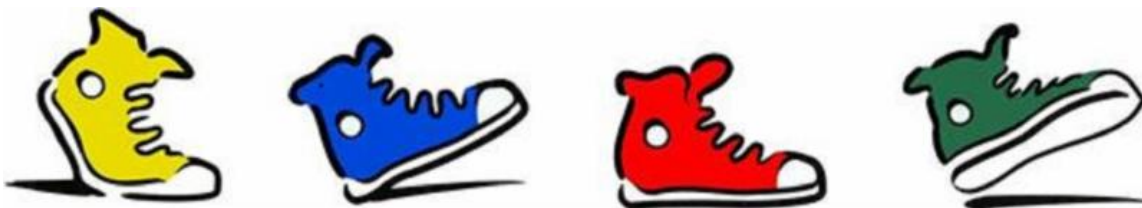

- All participants must be registered through the website by midnight on Sunday Sept. 24th.
