Bellevue School District Levy Vote is Feb. 13th

Bellevue School District Levies Need Your Continued Support For more than 2 decades, voters have passed levies supporting the Bellevue School District. This consistency of funding has created the robust, high-quality public education our students benefit from every day. The state does not - and will not - pay for the programs listed below. To keep them, voters will be asked in February to renew 2 expiring levies and approve a one-time collection levy to fund additional school buses. We hope you will VOTE YES to support our students.



Renew the Educational Programs and Operations Levy. It pays for:

- Music, band, orchestra and art for all elementary students
- 7th period classes and tutorial for all middle and high school students
- · World languages in middle schools and language immersion programs
- Athletics
- Gifted and Special Education programs
- Nurses, counselors, specialists and security supporting all students

Renew the Technology and Capital Projects Levy. It pays for:

- Smartboards, projectors, printers and other classroom technology
- Laptops for middle and high school students, shared laptop carts for all elementary students
- Digital curriculum supporting STEM learning throughout the day
- Technical staff supporting students, teachers and parents
- Major school building repairs including new flooring, roofing and HVAC

Approve the School Bus Levy. It pays for:

- New buses to support student enrollment growth for next 7-10 years
- Additional transportation to help families and reduce traffic around schools


