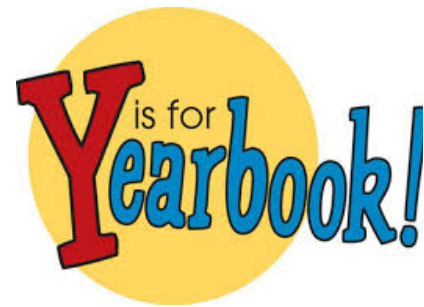
Yearbook
